Emergency Checklist

- ☐ Get emergency contact information from your clinic in the event the facility is damaged or destroyed in a disaster.
- ☐ Make sure your dialysis clinic has your correct contact information.
- ☐ Get a 3-day meal plan from your clinic in case dialysis services are delayed/unavailable.
- ☐ Stock foods for your 3-day emergency meals.
- ☐ Keep copies of your insurance cards, dialysis prescription, and medications in a water-proof container.
- ☐ Get medical identification jewelry or a card to keep on you at all times.

THE FACTS

Dialysis facilities should have designated back-up facilities.

Until the situation is resolved, you may be assigned to other locations for treatment. Treatments may also be limited.
